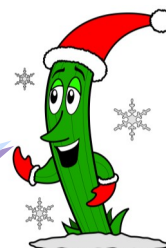

Then in the Spring this stored food is released and your grass becomes strong, beautiful and healthy!

DORMANT SEED YOUR LAWN

If you missed your opportunity to seed in the fall, you should consider dormant seeding. We use the same process as fall seeding when we dormant seed. The main difference is that we apply the seed when soil temperatures are too cold for germination. (Dec. & Jan.) When the soil becomes warm enough in the spring, it then germinates. Fall is always the best time to seed. However, if you did not seed in the fall or if you did not do a good job watering your fall seeding, dormant seeding may be right for you.

We hope you have a great Holiday Season. Before you get super busy with the holiday hustle and bustle. Remember that there are still a few things to do around your lawn. Here are a few items to check off your list to do around your lawn & landscape:

- Schedule a Root Feeding for your trees and shrubs.**
- Pick leaves up so they don't smother lawn. Mow and bag, or rake leaves weekly.
- If you did not do a Fall Seeding, consider Dormant Seeding this Winter.**
- Continue to mow lawn as needed at 3" thru November & December.
- Prune your trees and shrubs.**
- Fall is a great time to mulch beds and trees.
- Water lawn during warm, dry periods.
- Plant a tree!**
